HOW THE FINANCIAL MODEL WORKS

No upfront school equipment purchase required.

INITIAL EQUIPMENT



Schools do not have to come out of pocket for the recommended equipment deployed through the **Code Red** program model.

SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES



For subscription-based tools or platforms, **Code Red** plans to cover the first year to eliminate barriers to adoption.

LONG-TERM SUSTAINMENT



After year one, follow-on subscription costs would be covered either by the school or by any remaining funds dedicated to that district, if available.
